What's in a Name?

In Sunday services, we are finding out more about God's identity and character as we study some of the 1000s of his names and descriptive titles, many used in the Psalms. So far we have looked at

LORD – *YHWH* (Yahweh – 'I AM THAT I AM'), the great Unchangeable, ever Present One. What a relief to have eternal stability in our unstable, unsettled world, a God we can trust utterly because he is always there/ here!



FORTRESS – When we are under attack from worries, stress or in trouble, where do we go? Sometimes we turn to faulty relationships or old, bad habits. But our only place and person of true safety and security is God our Fortress. Psalm 91

HESED – Impossible to translate by a single word in English. Loving mercifulness, steadfast-love, unfailing-love, grace, loving-kindness... Unfaltering, unwavering, loyal love...

Wow! This is the God who loves us!



CORRECTIONS FROM CHRISTIAN HEROES

John McConnachie talked of a Scottish priest, called **Frank Forbes**, who was HIS UNCLE and fought for justice for slaves and served the poor ...in Rhodesia and South Africa...


